Engineering postgrads with an edge

KOLEJ Universiti Kejuruteraan dan Teknologi Malaysia (Kuktem) was established by the Government on Feb 16 2002. Based in Kuantan, Kuktem focuses on two major areas - Chemical Engineering and Industrial Biotechnology, and Automotive Engineering and Manufacturing.

The University currently has five faculties namely - Faculty of Mechanical Engineering; Faculty of Electrical and Electronics Engineering; Faculty of

Chemical and Natural Resources Engineering; Faculty of Civil and Environmental Engineering; and Faculty of Computer Systems and Software Engineering.

Kuktem offers a wide range of postgraduate programmes mainly in engineering for both part-time and full-time students. Currently, all postgraduate programmes offered by the university are research based. Plans have been made to offer postgraduate pro-

grammes in coursework mode in the near future.

The Centre for Graduate Studies of the University is responsible for ensuring the smooth running of Kuktem postgraduate programmes. For the 2005/2006 Session, Kuktem offers a total of 18 postgraduate programmes (nine Master's programmes and nine doctorate programmes).

Currently, the university operates at a temporary campus in the industrial area of

Gambang, situated about 30km west of Kuantan, just two-and-a-half hours away by road from Kuala Lumpur. It is equipped with wireless connection to facilitate the e-learning and e-management environment practised at the University.
